Student Dormitories are a part of University of Maribor. They offer accommodation for 2799 students that are studying in the University of Maribor. Standard of living in student dormitories is on a high level and offers the best conditions for studying and living. Renovation works of older dormitories are constantly present.

Approximately 150 beds per semester are reserved for Erasmus, Ceepus, IAESTE, for students with scholarships, and also some exceptions, if we have free capacities.

THE ADVENTAGE OF LIVING IN STUDENT DORMITORIES

- Students can live on 5 locations – all of them are near the faculties: Gospodsvetska, Tyrševa, Koroška - LENT, Smetanova and Gorkega – QUADRO.
- **Rent per semester** (all costs included), depends on the dorm and varies from 535,20 € to 847,20 €. Price list is on the webpage.
- Double and single rooms, free bed linen.
- Kitchen, bathroom and toilets are shared by 2-9 students.
- Free internet – students need their own UTP cable.
- Day and night security.
- Cleaning by the cleaning service (except rooms and apartments).

There are plenty of opportunities for sports, recreation and study. On campuses students can use:

- Fitness facilities, a gym, at the Gospodsvetska complex there are grounds and a big sports centre named after the great Olympian Leon Štukelj, swimming for free once a month, near campus Gorkega (QUADRO) is a sports hall Dvorana Tabor, basketball and tennis courts, football field and skating hall called Ledna dvorana Tabor, Planet Tuš with cinema halls and bowling centre.
- Computer centre with many computers and free internet access.
- Rooms for painting (for students who study art), music rooms (for students that are playing different instruments).
- Rooms for parties.
- Rooms with washing machines and dryers that students can use for free.
- On campus Lent and Smetanova students can use the underground garages.

FOREIGN STUDENTS - HOW TO MAKE A RESERVATION

Before making reservation in Student Dormitories you must be accepted at University in Maribor. After you receive your Acceptance Letter, someone from International Office at Maribor's University will contact you with an accommodation offer. Exceptionally you can contact us.

You will decide for one of the dorms that will be offered to you. The rules of living in Student Dormitories and the acceptance of rules will be send to you. You have to read the rules carefully and if you agree with them, you should sign the acceptance of rules and send them back by email. When the acceptance of rules will be send back, you will receive the confirmation of your accommodation.

Foreign students who will be accommodated in dormitory have to pay the deposit before arrival. All information about the deposit payment (when to pay it and the account number) will be send to you by email. The deposit will be transferred back to your account after your departure, if no damage was done. Erasmus students who decide for accommodation have to pay the rent per semester in one single instalment. The price list you can check on WEB PAGE.

We will inform you about the date; when you can arrive to the dormitories. When you arrive into the dorm you will receive the keys for your room from the receptionist (someone is on duty 24 hours all year). The day after your arrival in student dormitory you must come to the Student Office to arrange everything about your accommodation in a dorm. You will receive a contract and a dormitory card.
